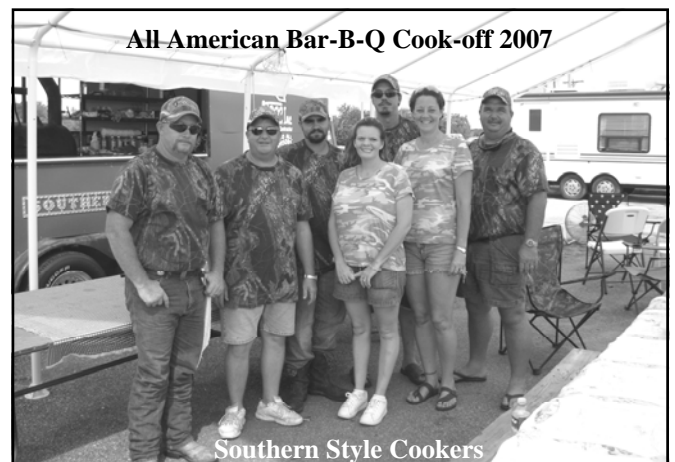

# Learn to Swim

Help your child learn essential motor skills while developing an awareness for the water, increasing their self confidence while having fun! Enroll your child in any of our many Red Cross Learn - To - Swim Classes.

## RED CROSS CERTIFIED

Our Learn-to-Swim Instructors are American Red Cross Certified. Water Safety Instructors' are persons 16 years or older with swimming experience who have gone through 36+ hours of instruction to effectively teach you or your child to swim and be safe in a water environment.

## FIRST DAY EVALUATIONS

On the first day of each session, students will be informally evaluated to determine whether or not they are in the appropriate class. Necessary adjustments will be made during this time.

## WATERBABIES: 9-36 months

This class is an instruction class for babies and their parents. It helps the children become comfortable in the water as they develop a readiness to swim. The parents and the instructor work together to help children adjust to the water.

## WATERTOTS: 3-4 years

These lessons are for first time swimmers and focus on the orientation of participants to the aquatic environment. It will teach elementary aquatic locomotive skills.

## LEVEL I

These lessons are for first time swimmers and focus on the orientation of participants to the aquatic environment. It will teach elementary aquatic locomotive skills.

## LEVEL II

This class is designed for swimmers who have successfully completed Level I and are ready to build on the basic water skills.

## LEVEL III

This class is designed for swimmers who have successfully completed Level II and have all the basic swimming skills. These swimmers should be ready to enhance stroke development and endurance

## LEVEL IV Stroke Improvement

This class is designed for swimmers who have successfully completed Level III. The students will develop confidence and competency in the aquatic environment, locomotion, safety and rescue skills.

## LEVEL V Stroke Refinement

This class is designed to coordinate and refine key strokes presented in the Learn-to-Swim program and to introduce many skills used in competitive swimming.

## LEVEL VI Personal Water Safety

This class is designed for swimmers to strengthen and polish their strokes, learn personal safety and rescue skills (this training does not certify the student as a professional rescuer).

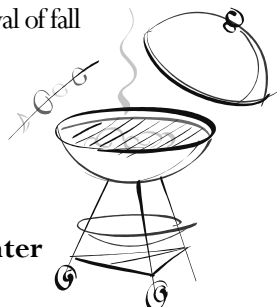

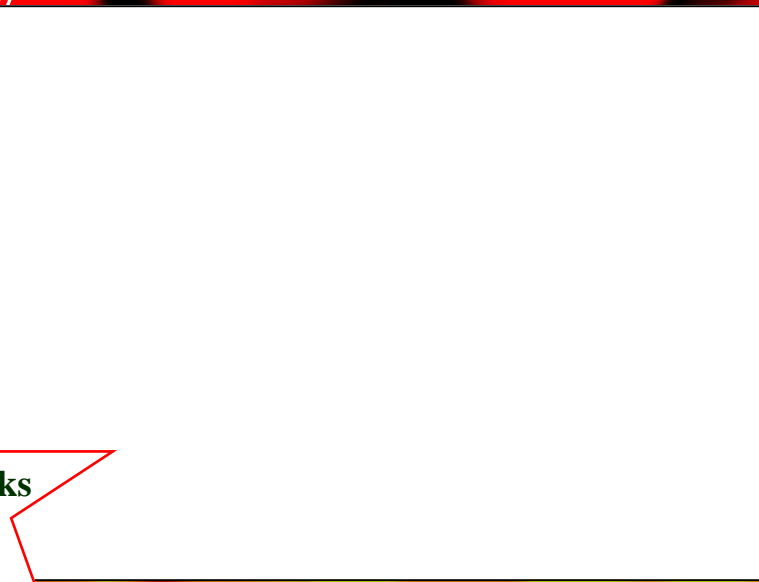
